Course Description

- Architectural Design I students will gain knowledge and skills needed to enter a career in architecture or
 construction or prepare a foundation toward a postsecondary degree in architecture, construction
 science, drafting, interior design, or landscape architecture. Architectural Design I includes the knowledge
 of the design, design history, techniques, and tools related to the production of drawings, renderings, and
 scaled models for nonresidential or residential architectural purposes. Prerequisite: None
- Architectural Design II students will gain advanced knowledge and skills needed to enter a career in architecture or construction or prepare a foundation toward a postsecondary degree in architecture, construction science, drafting, interior design, or landscape architecture. Architectural Design II includes the advanced knowledge of the design, design history, techniques, and tools related to the production of drawings, renderings, and scaled models for nonresidential or residential architectural purposes. Prerequisite: Architectural Design I
- Practicum in Architectural Design focuses on designing, planning, managing, building, and maintaining the built
 environment. Practicum in Architectural Design is an occupationally specific course designed to provide technical
 instruction in architectural design. Safety and career opportunities are included in addition to work ethics and
 architectural design study. Prerequisite: Architectural Design II
